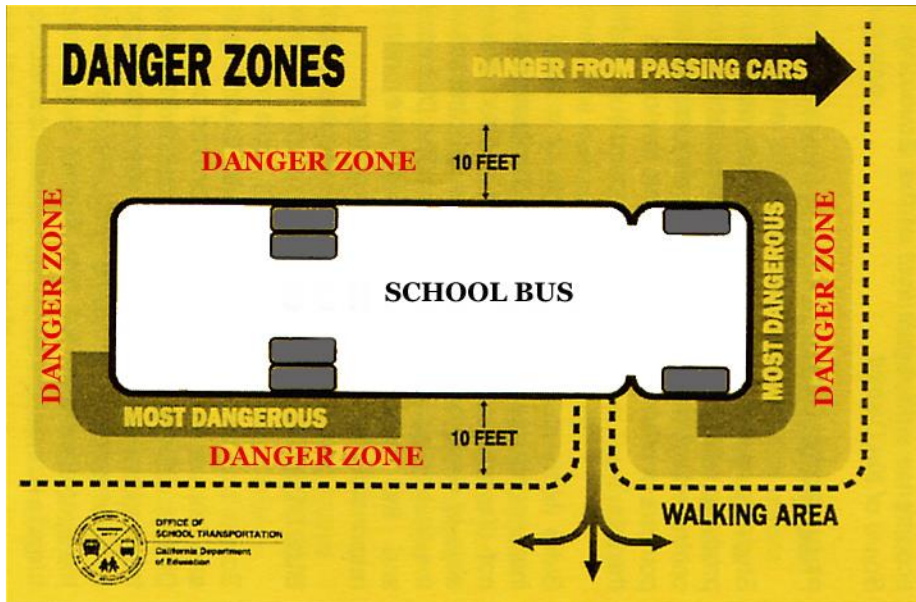




Millington Community Schools Rules on the School Bus and Bus Stop

- 1. Make sure your child is on time to the bus stop (Have them out 5 minutes prior to there scheduled pickup time.**
- 2. Never run while trying to board the bus.**
- 3. Do not push or shove other students when boarding the school bus. (Always use the handrail when boarding the bus.**
- 4. While on bus always remain seated in your assigned seat.**
- 5. Vandalism of school buses may result in suspension or revocation of the student's riding privilege; parents may be held financially liable for the cost of repairing damage to the school bus.**
- 6. Never place your arms and limbs out of the window.**
- 7. Do not yell while on the bus (yelling could distract the driver and cause a accident)**
- 8. No eating or drinking permitted.**
- 9. No profanity (this includes abusive language, obscene or profane gestures to students and driver.**
- 10. Keep musical instruments and back packs out of isle on the bus.**
- 11. Keep hands your hands , feet and legs to yourself**
- 12. Absolutely no fighting on the bus and bus stop.**
- 13. No smoking, drugs, and or alcohol on bus at any time.**
- 14. While at bus stop please wait 10 feet away from curb or roadway.**
- 15. Always cross at least 10 feet in front of the bus. (Wait for driver to direct you across the road.)**
- 16. Stay out of the DANGER ZONE (10 ft away from any side of the school bus.) SEE DIAGRAM BELOW.**
- 17. Always listen to the bus driver and follow his/her instructions.**
- 18. Do not throw any items or trash out the window.**
- 19. Never crawl under the bus. If you drop something when getting off the bus DON'T PICK IT UP. Let the bus driver know.**
- 20. Student behavior may be monitored by video recording devices mounted in the school bus. Video tapes may be used by school administrators in disciplinary proceedings.**
- 21. Students must not bring , glass, aerosol products, dangerous objects, flammable or controlled substances, laser pointers, radios, cassette players, or other personal electronic devices .**

22. Electronic devices may be used on the bus, but in the event that the electronic device becomes disruptive to the safe and orderly transport of all students the privilege of use of device will be revoked by School Personnel.
23. Consequences for violating Bus Conduct Code is treated the same as in a class room.



Please keep in mind that all the rules on the bus and at the school bus stop are in place to help keep your student safe. We ask that as parents you ensure that your student / students know the rules on the bus and at the bus stop and follow them at all times. Riding a school bus is a privilege not a right.
